# Gate Camera failure on Apr 29, 0510

The "new" hi-res gate camera stopped working on Monday Apr 29 at ~5:10am. The new, high performance 8mp 60fps camera was installed on the guard shack by Daryl & Andrew from Will Electronics on Jan 3, 2024.

When I unscrewed the camera from its mount to test it, a substantial amount of water poured out. When the camera was hooked up at our house, it was dead.

There was substantial rain between 3-5am on Apr 29 which probably caused the camera to fail. The camera probably needed better weather protection. It looked like one of the seals failed or was installed improperly. Will Electronics was contacted about the problem.

Ben from Will Elect worked on the camera for about 4hrs (0915->1315) on May 7 to install the new replacement camera. Not sure why it took so long. In any case Janet & I assisted while he was here. The two cameras on the GS are now mounted vertically. This should make them less susceptible to water ingress.

Turns out that the new camera worked intermittently. Brandon (Will E) tried to get the new camera working May 10. He replaced or substituted pretty much every component without success. The camera is still intermittent. At this point it is believed that the replacement camera is at fault.

#### <u>Gate</u>

Brandon was going to contact the camera manufacturer & ExacqVision (the software publisher). (That's a totally different problem I won't discuss here). We have not yet heard from Brandon.

# <u>Maintenance</u>

1. Last year we borrowed a lift for the patrol boat. Ken is looking into the purchase of a used lift for this year and ongoing. He is also going to investigate which docks in front of the beach area are owned by the LTPOA. Hopefully one of these docks can be used for the patrol boat lift.
