- CD Specials
 - o 6 month 4.57% interest rate with 4.65% annual yield
 - o 13 month 4.81% interest rate with 4.9% annual yield
- Move money from Checking to the Money Market account to earn a little bit more. Money Market earns 1.15% for balances of \$50,000 to \$300,00 and 1.4% for balances \$300,000 and up. The checking account earns .65%.

- Items approved by email:
 - o Bid of \$2,475 to spray water willow was approved on 07/16.
 - Bid of \$2,050 to repair the forgotten portion of South Lakeshore Dr. was approved on 07/17 and will be added to the already approved road improvements. This bid includes the road as you go past the volleyball/beach area, then across the inlet creek, up the hill and turn left.
 - Approved on 08/01 for five new tires for the can removal trailer at approximately \$620
 and new Bobcat tires, including replacement tires with service calls, at a price that will
 be less than \$2,000.
 - Approved on 08/06 Our server provider, Colburn Consulting, can obtain the SSL security certificate at the cost of \$75 per year.

Security

- The gate bar was accidentally knocked off on Sunday, August 11th. It has been restored.
- Mark contacted the lawyer to ask if we can prosecute the individuals who are performing donuts in the Community House parking lot. Although we do have documentation of the offense by using the gate camera footage, the prosecution for property damage is an expensive, long drawn out process. Also, we can only prosecute for property damage if the individual is a Lake Tishomingo resident. If the offender is not a resident of Lake Tishomingo our only recourse is to trespass them out of the Community House area. This would require the security staff to identify resident vs. non-resident status which is not feasible.
- Aaron's report:
 - He will continue to look into the boaters pulling tubes that are zig-zagging across the entire lake.
 - Next year he will adding a side-by-side vehicle to the security force. The vehicle will be marked with security stickers.
